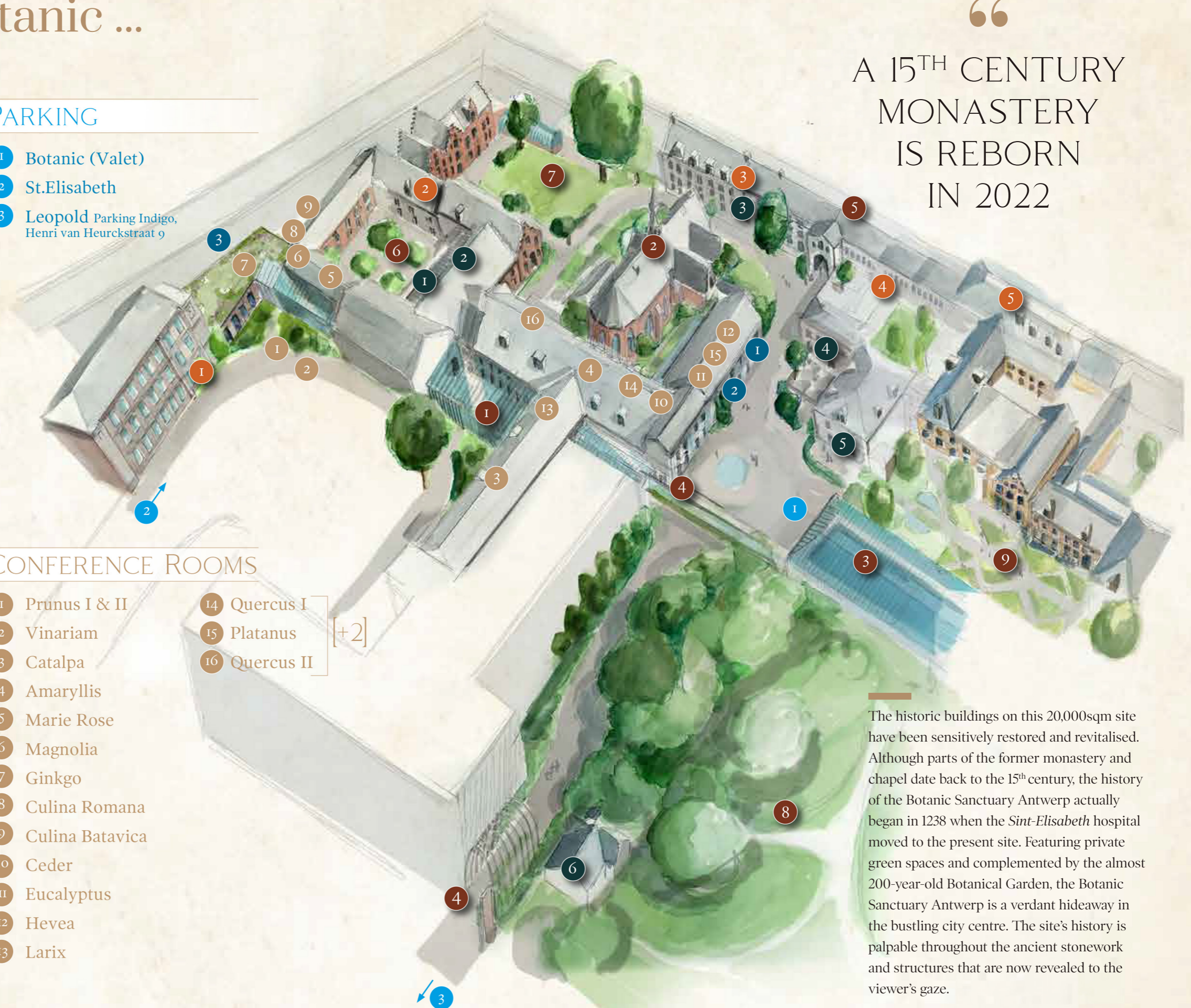

The historic buildings on this 20,000sqm site have been sensitively restored and revitalised. Although parts of the former monastery and chapel date back to the 15th century, the history of the Botanic Sanctuary Antwerp actually began in 1238 when the *Sint-Elisabeth* hospital moved to the present site. 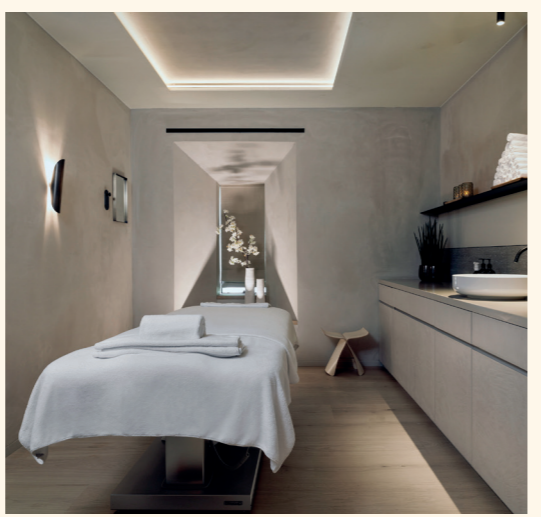
